Selection Process:

Selection of recipients is done by the Jefferson County Agri-Business Club Scholarship Committee and approved by the club membership at the February monthly meeting. Recipients will be recognized at the club's April meeting.

Scholarship funds will be dispersed after volunteer hours have been met and after proof of successful completion of first semester classes, indicating you are a student in good standing with a GPA of at least 2.0.
