The Jefferson County Agri-Business Club would like to invite you and your school's fourth grade classes to the **30<sup>th</sup> Annual Farm Tour**. We're excited to announce that this year's tour will again be held at Kutz Family Dairy Farm owned and operated by Ron, Pam, Allan and Aaron Kutz. The dairy is located at N3612 Will Road, Jefferson.

Ron and Pam started Kutz Dairy in 1973 with 10 Holstein cows. Over the years they have gradually increased their milking herd and by 1994 they were milking 250 Holstein cows. Today Kutz Dairy LLC milks approximately 2,000 Jersey cows and raises 1,700 replacement heifers. They have a stunning progressive dairy that we are pleased to showcase.

The farm tour will be held on Wednesday, May 7, 2025 and will be structured similarly to past events. The approximately 2-hour tour will have around 11 stations set-up throughout the dairy farm. These stations include dairy and crop production, raising calves, milk house, beef/swine, sheep/goats, land preservation, and agriculture careers. A <u>free</u> brown bag lunch prepared by the Jefferson County Farm Bureau and Agri-Business Club will be provided.
